ANNUAL PARADE

When and Where To Be

This year's parade is on Thursday, September 10, 2020. Parade registration and line-up will begin by 4:30 PM. Opening ceremonies will begin at 6 PM with the parade immediately following. The parade route will begin at the intersection of High Street and Main Street (US 36), proceed east down Main Street, and end in front of the Old Junior High Site (370 E. Main Street).



ROUTE & Sign-In



Our route is based on last year's festival.

- 1) Line-up will be on South High Street (south of US 36),
Grand Marshal, Queen & Princess, Contestants, Band
Walnut Street & Poplar Street (between South High and Church Streets)
Other participants, teams, organizations, businesses, etc.

Horses: please park in the grass area behind the Pony Wagon Museum (enter along Springfield Street)
you will enter the parade through the Poplar Street line-up

- 2) **Bring your entry form with you to the parade line-up!** We will have extras on hand.
- 3) After you are in the line-up, someone will pick-up your entry and give you a parade number.

The parade route will begin at the intersection of Main Street & South High Street, proceed east, and end at the Festival (the Old Junior High Site, 370 E. Main). Individuals may turn right onto Ashland to return to the beginning of the parade if needed.

Parade Rules

1. No "FOR SALE" signs are allowed on any vehicle or parade unit.
2. No throwing or handing of candy or other items from moving vehicles.
You may have people walk along unit and pass/hand out candy.
3. Consumption of alcohol or other intoxicants is not permitted in the staging area or along the parade route.
4. **Attention Participants with Animals:** Sudden loud noises should be expected along the parade route. It is your responsibility to maintain control of your animal for the safety of people along the parade route, as well as fellow parade participants. If your animal spooks or scares easily, please refrain from bringing it to the parade.
